

Teamwork Trivia is a competitive, fun contest where tables compete against other tables by answering general knowledge questions.

The host, Ed Mullen, has researched a wide variety of brain-teasers and conducts this team-building quiz.

The "eight to ten" person table discusses possible answers and then as a team, they decide upon an answer. Then, the table-leader writes down the answer on the provided answer sheet. Ten questions are asked then those answer sheets are passed to a nearby table.

Then, the ten answers are announced to the delight or despair of the players. The score is tallied and the sheets are collected, which ends one round. There is a break after each two round set. There are six rounds, then a final seventh round.

Round 1+2   Break   Round 3+4   Break   Round 5+6   Break   Final Round 7

This allows three breaks for raffles ticket sales, auctions, and just walking around. Note that the last "break" should be reserved for your announced or posted raffle winners. Use this last "break" as you see fit, keeping in mind that the audience usually adjourns after the seventh round score is tallied.
